The KPBSD requires that **all** volunteers have a criminal background check **before** working with students. A letter was sent home on the first day explaining this process. If you were a volunteer last year, you should have received an e-mail this summer asking you if you would like to continue to volunteer. Please say “YES!” Background checks can take up to 10 working days so please complete yours as soon as possible. If you have any questions, call the school office.
